TOURISM

Arts and culture attracts
156 million domestic and
international travelers — who
stay longer and spend more
money than other travelers.

EDUCATION

Students who benefit from arts education have *higher GPAs and standardized test scores and lower drop-out rates*.

Students with four years of arts or music in high school average 100 points better on their SAT scores than students with just one-half year of arts or music.

JOBS

The arts and culture sector supports 4.7 million workers.

For every 100 jobs created from new demand for the arts, 62 additional jobs are also created.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The arts contribute *\$698 billion* to the U.S. economy.

The arts and culture sector represents 4.32 percent of the nation's GDP— a larger share of the economy than tourism and agriculture.


Arts and culture spending has a ripple effect on the overall economy, boosting both commodities and jobs.
