## HELPS OUR COMMUNITIES THRIVE

Did you know, in 2016 alone, the NEA awarded a total of **\$1,299,537** in federal grants to 21 nonprofit and governmental arts organizations throughout the state of Utah?

These grants worked to enhance access to the arts for all, especially in underserved rural and innercity areas. Of this NEA funding, more than \$730,000 went to the Utah Arts Council. The state then matched these federal funds and awarded grants to over 200 nonprofit arts organizations across Utah.

Last year, 13 organizations in the greater Salt Lake City area received grants directly from the NEA, totaling **\$227,500**.
